

By Laws
Greater Richmond Senior Men's Golf Association

Article I . Name

The Name of this Association shall be "Greater Richmond Senior Men's Golf Association".

Article II. Purpose

The purpose of this Association shall be to promote fellowship among the senior male golfers in the greater Richmond area through the sponsorship of regularly scheduled golf tournaments.

Article III. Membership

Section 1. Membership in the Greater Richmond Senior Men's Golf Association shall be limited to private country clubs located in the greater Richmond area. Individual players must be members of member clubs or guests of GRSMGA Captains and be age 50, or older to qualify for participation in sponsored golf tournaments.

Member clubs are to be "grandfathered" as members if their clubs become semi-private.

Section 2. Membership in this Association shall be by invitation only. A qualifying club must be nominated and sponsored by representatives of two member clubs and acceptance into membership shall require approval of representatives of a majority of the member clubs.

Section 3. Continuing Membership in this Association shall be Contingent upon the Private Club: (1) Authorizing or Approving Membership in this Association, and (2) Agreeing to make their course available each year to host one of the Association Tournaments.

Article IV . Dues and Assessments

Section 1. There shall be no dues or assessments charged for membership in this Association.

Section 2. Self-supporting activity fees to be paid by the participants shall be established by the Association.

Article V. Management

Section 1. The Management of this Association, it's affairs and funds, shall be entrusted to an Executive Committee which shall be comprised of a Chairman, Vice-chairman, Secretary, and the Immediate past Chairman.

Section 2. The Officers of the Association shall consist of Chairman, Vice-chairman, Secretary and Treasurer.

Section 3. There shall be at least two meetings annually: a fall meeting following the last tournament for the purpose of electing a Chairman, Vice -Chairman, and Secretary, whose duties shall commence after the meeting, and a winter or spring meeting for conducting current year and other appropriate business.

Section 4. The Executive Committee shall, in coordination with representatives of the member Clubs, schedule tournaments and establish the procedures for tournament play.

Section 5. The Executive Committee shall appoint the necessary committees to carry out the activities of the Association.

Section 6. Meetings of the Executive Committee shall be at the Call of the Chairman or representatives of any three Member clubs.

Section 7. The By-laws of the Association may be amended by two-thirds vote of the Member Clubs' Representatives (one vote per club) plus Officers.
